

Since May, Cirrus has released many new enhancements to our solutions:


Self-Service Log Metrics

New Authentication Proxy Implementations


The first half of 2022 has been busy for Cirrus and our customers! We have several institutions that have implemented the Cirrus Authentication Proxy to:
